



# First aid fact sheet

## First aid kit

**A first aid kit is an essential item for the home, workplace and vehicles.**

Check the contents of your kit regularly, and ensure that:

- items have been cleaned
- packets are properly sealed
- items have not exceeded expiry dates
- previously used items have been replaced
- everybody knows where the first aid kit is kept!
